



## Academy for Anthroposophical Education

Located next to the Goetheanum, the AfaP (Academy for Anthroposophical Education) in Dornach, Switzerland offers a variety of courses to prospective Waldorf educators, including preschool teachers. Following a mandatory introductory course in Waldorf education, students are free to design a program tailored to their ambitions and interests. Modules regularly on offer include specializations in FLT, P.E., the arts, and music. Major emphasis is placed on practice-based research (action research), with each student completing a thesis informed by the methods of practice-based research.



The Academy awards two diplomas: Diploma I entitles graduates to accept entry-level positions in their field; Diploma II is awarded after one year of practical training (*Referendariat*). Furthermore, the University of Northwestern Switzerland awards extra credit to Diploma I holders, allowing them to complete the Bachelor of Education required to teach in public schools in 3-4 (instead of 6) semesters.
